Presence. We experience His goodness, steadfast love, and His
faithfulness to us and our children. Hallelujah

There is so much that happens in worship. What we must learn
as Kingdom Marchers is that worship is a divine exchange. We
worship in spirit and in truth. God responds. He can't help but
respond.

What is spirit and in truth? I'm convinced that worship in the
spirit is worship where you are fully engaged, body, soul and
spirit. It's a sold-out, zeal for God's presence. Worshiping in truth
is you submit your heart, your authentic self, to the God of love.

THE POWER OF BLESSING

Right now I want you to write out a blessing over yourself. You can bless yourself with divine health, provision, joy, peace, and so much more. Be lavish in this exercise. Don't hold back. Bless yourself and then teach yourself to bless others.

TRUTH

The Kingdom lifestyle is filled with worship and blessings. If you take only these two attributes alone from the Kingdom of God, and practiced them with intention daily, you will change everything in your life. People would want to be around you; they would come to you for prayer and for advice. They would seek you out because you become the aroma of Christ through worship and blessing.

ACTIVATION

Worship:

Give yourself permission to express your heart in private worship and in corporate worship. While in worship, ask the Lord to reveal to you what is happening in the atmosphere.
